




Established in 1992, Chesapeake Care Clinic has a rich history of compassion & commitment. As a safety net provider for low-income, uninsured adults in Hampton Roads, Virginia, we strive to provide essential healthcare services to improve the health of our community. By improving the health of our patients, they are able to return to work, raise their children, take care of elderly parents, & become more productive members of society, resulting in a better future for our community. Chesapeake Care Clinic provides dental, medical, and specialty care as well as behavioral health counseling, health promotion classes, & medication assistance.

Joy first came to Chesapeake Care in June 2020 after losing her Medicaid. She had chronic respiratory failure, as well as severe chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, which required continuous oxygen and use of a BiPAP machine at night. Chesapeake Care made it possible for Joy to see a pulmonologist and worked to get her a portable nebulizer. Joy was able to receive all of her medications through the clinic, including her newly prescribed nebulizer medication. Joy shared, "Chesapeake Care took great care of me & made me a new person."














To stop the pain, Chesapeake Care's volunteer dentists removed nine teeth over three appointments. Maria was then fitted for dentures to give her a beautiful new smile. She earns \$6,000 annually working at Marshall's so she thought she could never afford to have her teeth extracted, let alone dentures. Maria said, "Everyone there is nice, respectful, and treats everyone with dignity" and "I am very thankful and appreciative for what they did for me." 


